This is to inform the faculty members and Four Year Under Graduate Programme (FYUGP) and Two Year Post Graduate students (all semesters) of Sibsagar University that as decided in the meeting of the Heads of Departments of the University in presence of hon'ble Vice Chancellor held on 16-09-2025, the following modifications in respect of conducting assessment and evaluation of Practicum courses are notified for all concerned.

- The practice of continuous assessment and evaluation shall be adopted for all practicum courses having equal or less than two (2) credits in any semester of FYUGP and Two Year PG.
- The practicum courses having more than two (2) credits in any semester of FYUGP and Two Year PG shall be evaluated through both external and internal evaluators.
- End Semester Practical Examinations shall be conducted in a flexible manner and the schedule may be fixed tentatively during the period from the second week of November up to the preparatory break.

A suggestive template of conducting continuous assessment and evaluation of the practicum courses having equal or less than two (2) credits in any semester of FYUGP and Two Year PG is provided. However, the Departments shall have the flexibility of making minor changes of the components of assessment and evaluation of the practicum which is to be submitted to the Vice Chancellor for his approval.
