In pursuance of the University's commitment towards promoting innovation, entrepreneurship, and self-reliance among students, Sibsagar University is pleased to launch a Monthly Entrepreneurial Stall Initiative titled "আত্মনির্ভরশীলতার দিশে এখোজ" (A Step Towards Self-Reliance) under the supervision of the Institution's Innovation Council (IIC). The initiative aims to provide a platform for students to showcase and sell products prepared or arranged independently from their homes, thereby encouraging entrepreneurship, innovation, and practical business skills. The scheme shall be implemented with effect from the month of August, 2026.

1. Schedule

The initiative will be organized on the first Saturday of every month.

Timing: 11:00 AM onwards to 4:00 PM.

Student vendors must attend regular classes from 11:00 AM to 2:00 PM before participating in stall activities.

2. Stall Arrangement

A total of 6 (six) stalls will be arranged by the University.

Each stall may be operated individually or by a group of up to three students.

Basic facilities will be provided by the University.

Participation shall be free of cost.

3. Nature of Items Permitted

Participants may sell:

Homemade food items

Fresh vegetables including indigenous vegetables

Handcrafted products

Other locally produced goods

Items sourced or purchased from outside the district shall not be permitted.

4. Registration

Interested students must register with the concerned authority between the 20th and 30th of every month for participation in the following month's event.

5. Selection Procedure

In case applications exceed available stalls, selection shall be made on a rotational and merit basis considering originality of products, preference to new participants, and previous participation records.

6. Rules and Responsibilities

Cleanliness and hygiene must be maintained, especially for food items.

No harmful or prohibited items shall be allowed.

Prices should not exceed prevailing local market rates.


Participants must maintain discipline and ensure no disruption to regular academic activities.

7. Monitoring and Supervision

The overall implementation and supervision of the initiative shall remain under the purview of the Institution's Innovation Council (IIC), with regular monitoring by a Sub-Committee headed by the Dean of Students' Welfare (DSW).

All students are encouraged to participate actively in this initiative and utilize the platform to develop entrepreneurial and self-reliance skills.
